





Post-LOC National Society support program

Any country can run an annual congress even joint with other countries and even if congress venues are locally too small, EAACI also supports congress chairs from other countries. EAACI generally supports the national society activities to advocate allergy at the local governments by letters, site visits of the EAACI leadership or other activities.

Besides visibility of the annual meeting and income of the hosting city, EAACI wishes to support successful recruitment of the National Societies to EAACI annual meeting by offering

- speaker support to the NS national meetings particular post congress
- providing EAACI fellowships (both in- and out-coming) post-congress (1 position for 100 more national delegates in comparison to average of previous 5 years).
- 1 page free advertisement of up-coming National meeting in the final e-programme.
- A booth, which illustrates the local allergy research place (also including Research institutions) is possible and can be adapted to the local situations (eg emergency exit plans etc). Equipment is responsibility of the NS.
- Local activities such as allergy campaigns in the city during the event are supported if a sponsor can be found for this. Preferred are long-lasting activities such as the installation of the Pollen-Indicator column in Munich.








Members in good standing 2015 - 2018






Membership income 2015 - 2018


