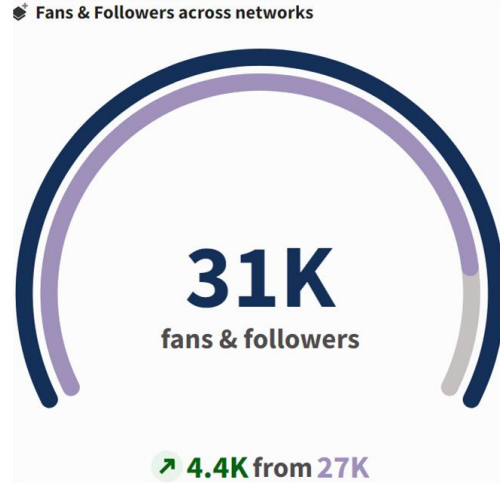

In a special program for the 20th anniversary, delegates will attend the classical Keynote lectures and scientific Stand-up talks on the newest discoveries in the fields of basic and clinical immunology, allergy and asthma. Moreover, participants will have a practical course on ground-breaking research technologies at the Swiss Institute for Allergy and Asthma Research (SIAF) in Davos. Additional educational, scientific and social activities led by the Board of the EAACI Basic and Clinical Immunology Section are also planned, all taking place in a friendly and highly interactive environment which will lead to the establishment of new collaborations and networks, and even to some valuable awards!

For the 20th anniversary meeting, we will be welcoming excellent Keynote Speakers such as: **Gábor Tamás Szabó**, from Biotech, Germany, sharing the success story of the mRNA vaccines; **Thomas Weichhart**, Austria, as an expert in immunometabolism; **Graham Ogg**, UK, who will discuss lipid-specific T cells and inflammatory skin diseases; **Paul Bastard**, France, talking about the immunology of COVID-19; **Federica Sallusto**, Switzerland, presenting T cell and B cell repertoires in infection and inflammation; and **Cezmi Akdis**, Switzerland, discussing the impact of the environment on epithelial barriers. The exclusive 20th Winter School Edition Scientific StandUp Talks will be given by the Keynote Speakers including **Oscar Palomares**, Spain, **Liam O'Mahony**, Ireland, and **Mary Prunicki**, US, sharing their research and insights on the intersection of environment and immunology. A special guest from the European Parliament, **Sirpa Pietikäinen**, Finland, will share how to raise awareness of a healthier environment. As the organiser of the first winter schools, Cezmi Akdis will also take us on a journey: "From the First to the Twentieth Winter School"; Stefano del Giacco, Italy, the current EAACI President, will share his personal story: "From Junior to EAACI President"; whilst Tomas Chivato, Spain, will present the portfolio of educational possibilities available within EAACI. We encourage all interested junior members from Europe and beyond to submit an abstract through the Winter School webpage (<https://eaaci.org/events/allergy/immunology-winter-school-2023/abstract-submission/>) and take the opportunity to be part of the unique EAACI Immunology Winter School 2023. Seventy young scientists, selected based on the quality of their submitted abstracts, will share their own new research findings that have not yet been published elsewhere and interact with the keynote speakers and scientific faculty. We are looking forward to receiving your abstracts for the Winter School 2023 and to welcoming you in Davos!
